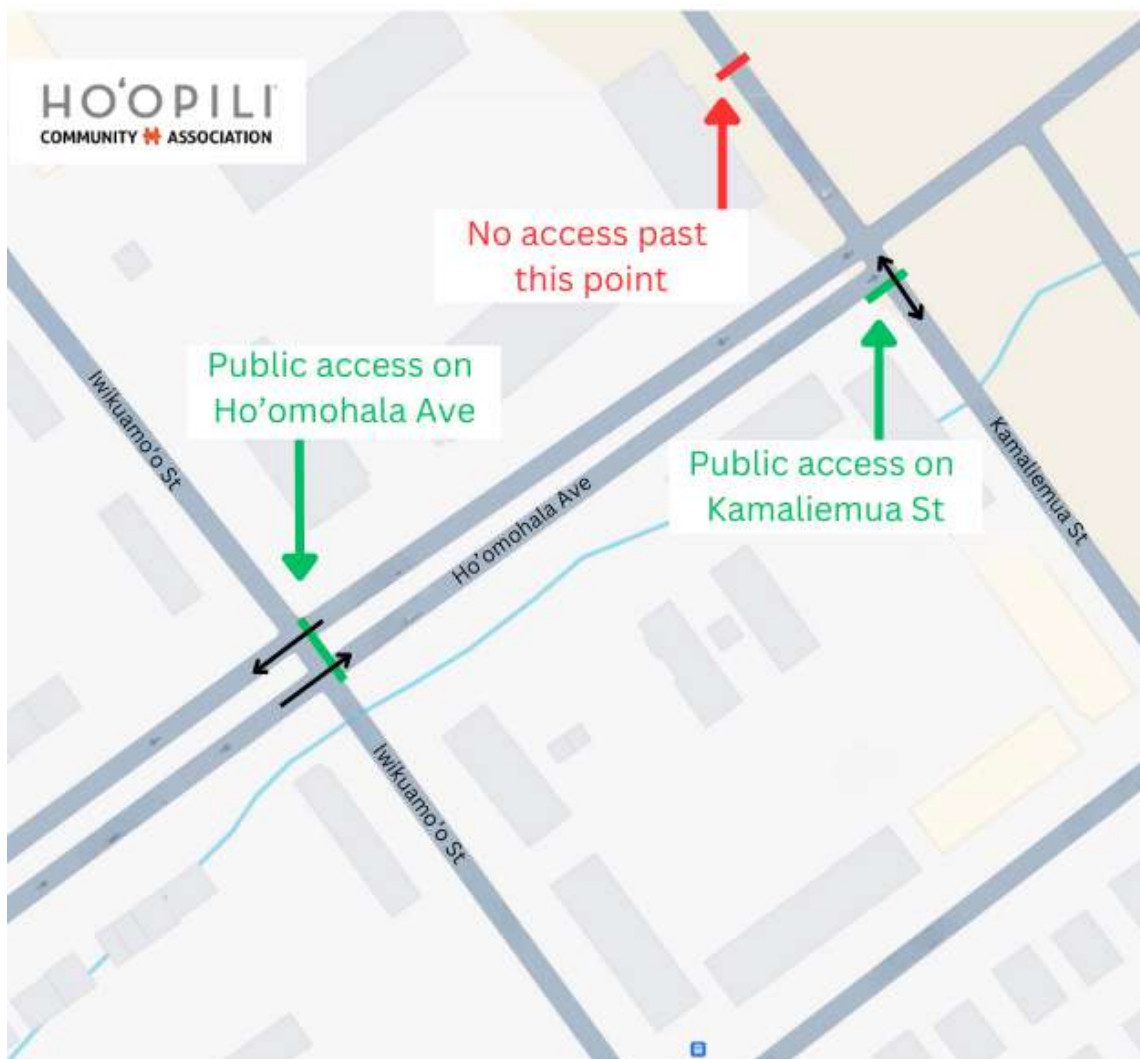

Pa'ani Park: Pa'ani Park, our newest community park is set to be completed this summer. This vibrant space will feature half basketball courts, pickleball courts, lawn volleyball courts, a children's playground, and a pavilion. Located conveniently next to the Temp 4J Soccer Field, Pa'ani Park promises endless fun for residents of all ages. More updates will follow soon.



New Public Access Roads: As our community expands, additional public roads are becoming accessible. Starting March 1st, 2024, both lanes of Ho'omohala Avenue at the Iwikuamoo Street intersection will be open to public access. Additionally, public access in both directions will be permitted on Kamaliemua Street at the intersection of Ho'omohala Avenue. Kindly ensure compliance with the stop signs located at the junction of Iwikuamoo Street and Hoomohala Avenue and watch for incoming traffic from both sides. New traffic barricades will be set up on the Nahele side of Kaneliemua Street. Please be aware of these new traffic patterns as you travel to and from your residence.



Unauthorized Street Pickleball Courts: We would like to bring to your attention an important matter regarding recent vandalism of a Ho'opili roadway that was painted with pickleball court lines. Residents within one of the single-family subdistricts allegedly painted these pickleball court lines. We would like to remind all residents that this behavior constitutes vandalism and is strictly prohibited. Please be advised that roads within Ho'opili are still pending dedication to the City & County of Honolulu. Ho'opili Community Association is obligated under the Ho'opili Master Declaration to maintain Common Area Roadways to the standard required by the City & County regarding roadway dedication until dedicated. We have not been able to determine the person(s) responsible for the unauthorized painting, and D.R. Horton Hawaii has agreed as a courtesy to absorb all costs of repair. We urge residents to refrain from damaging the common areas, including the roadways, by painting pickleball courts or any other markings. Going forward, parties found responsible for unauthorized painting or other vandalism of Common Area Roadways will be held accountable for all repairs, which may involve removing the paint and repaving the asphalt. We understand the excitement and anticipation regarding the establishment of pickleball courts within our community. Rest assured; D.R. Horton Hawaii has heard your call for courts and incorporated pickleball courts within the new Pa'ani Park under construction. We kindly request your patience as construction is completed and time allowed for the grass to grow in. Thank you for your attention and cooperation to ensure our streets meet City & County dedication standards.

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Ho'opili Termite Inspection Service at Group Discount Rates! Kilauea Pest Control is offering all residents within the Ho'opili Community a Subterranean Termite Inspection Service at a group discount rate. This will be a visual and audible interior and exterior Termite Inspection Service of the home (Excluding Ac Space). All interior and exterior wall edges of the garages, rooms, storage areas, lanai's, back patios, stairways, etc., need to be accessible for inspection prior to the appointment date and time. All base cabinets containing sinks within bathrooms, kitchens, laundry, garages, etc., need to be cleared for inspection prior to the appointment date and time. Any non-accessible areas at the time of inspection will be marked as "Inaccessible" and will not be re-inspected or rescheduled. This Group Discount Rate Termite Inspection Service is solely intended to satisfy the Ho'opili/DRHH Subterranean Termite Warranty Inspection Requirement for individual units. This service is not intended nor will be used for a home sale, refinance, etc. A "PC-09(TIR)" form will not be issued.
